



Dog 4H

For all events where you show your dog, wear nice clothes and no open toed shoes. Always remember to be polite and courteous when talking to the judges.

You and your Dog (Wednesday Night):

The kids will be taking a paper and pencil test covering the material they have learned for their age group and they will have an interview. Most of the questions are covered in the question bank for your age group.

- **Dog (well groomed)**
 - Nails cut
 - Teeth brushed
 - Eyes
 - Ears
 - Coat - Dog washed and free of ticks and fleas.
 - Collars
 - Flat buckle
 - Show leash
 - Leash
 - Treats
 - Water and water bowl
 - Plastic bags and Paper Towels for clean-up (in case of accidents)
 - Folding Chairs (for people)
 - Kennel or blanket for dog
- **Paperwork:**
 - Shot record (signed by you and the vet)
 - Dog License paper
- **Project**
 - Project
 - Points awarded for educational content, neatness and appearance, originality and presentation.
 - Project book completed



Dog Show

Bring a cage or place to keep dog.

All Paperwork (shot records, dog license papers)

- **Everything as outlined for the Skillathon above (water, trash bags, chairs etc.)**
 - Fans. It will be very hot and we will need to keep the dogs as comfortable as possible and cool them down.
 - Water and food/treats for you as well as the dogs.
 - Study materials.
- **Obedience**
 - All of the things we have practiced during the meetings.
 - Flat buckle collar (no tags)
 - 6ft Leash
- **Showmanship**
 - Interview questions from questions bank
 - Judged on: Appearance and attitude toward judge and your dog
 - Grooming
 - Handling: Show the bite, stack, gait, pattern consideration of others (are you ready) and watching the judge.
 - Show leash
