Guidelines for 2021 Junior/Senior Goat Ambassador Competition

- Both males and females are eligible to apply for Champaign County Junior/Senior Goat Ambassador.
- Junior Goat Ambassador – current 4-H member age 12-14 as of January 1, 2021
- Senior Goat Ambassador – current 4-H or FFA member age 15-18 as of January 1, 2021
- Candidates must have completed as least one previous year carrying a goat project and must be currently carrying a goat project in 2021.
- Candidates must be able to serve in this capacity for one year of service officially starting Friday August 6, 2021.
- Royalty must be available for the following activities, dressed appropriately and wearing royalty crown and sash or hat and shirt. Unless participating in other 4-H activities.
 - Saturday Open Show, Tuesday Born and Raised, Wednesday market show, Thursday King of Ring
 - Sale on Friday
 - 2021-2022 Parades
 - 2022 April Clinic
 - 2022 June Show
 - Subject to other events throughout the year.
- Previous Junior Goat Ambassadors MAY apply for Senior Goat Ambassador when age criteria is met. Previous Goat Ambassadors MAY re-apply; however, new applicants will be given preference. *Example: If applicant A is a previous Goat Ambassador and applicant B is a new applicant, applicant B will be awarded the Goat Ambassador title, providing applicant B meets the requirement.*
- Female ambassadors will receive a tiara and sash. Male ambassadors will receive a hat and shirt. These items are to be worn whenever performing official duties as ambassador and also during the fair.
- It is to be the complete desire of the 4-H/FFA member to participate in this position.
- Applicants must have complete support from family members to pursue this position and fulfill the required duties.
- **Applicants are responsible for completing the application, submitting essay answering two questions, “Why do you want to serve in the role of Champaign County Goat Ambassador?” and “Why would you be a good Ambassador for our goat program?” Applicant must submit current photo with essay and application.**
- Ambassadors are to present a polite, positive, sportsmanlike, and encouraging attitude at all times.
- Ambassadors are in no way inhibited from competing at the Champaign County Fair and will be excused from official duties, with prior authorization, to show their animals and/or assist another exhibitor in showing their animal, if needed.
- The selection of the ambassadors are at the discretion of the panel of judges. Their decision is final.

Application and Essay must be submitted by: FRIDAY, JUNE 11, 2021 BY 4PM

Interviews will be held Thursday, June 17th at 5pm – location TBA

Ambassadors will be announced Friday, August 6 following the market goat weigh in. Must be present to be awarded.
