

2021 Champaign County Fair Queen  
Contest  
Rules & Regulations

1. Contestants must be female, over 16 and not over 20 years of age as of January 1, 2021.
2. Contestants must not be married and have no children.
3. Contestants must be currently active in any one of the following organizations in Champaign County, Ohio:

4- H                  Girl Scouts                  FFA                  FCCLA

4. Each contestant must be of high moral standards and abide by the Champaign County Fair Rules & Regulations as posted in the Champaign County Fair Book.
5. Contestants will be judged on the following: Community Service, Scholastic Involvement, Knowledge of Current Events, Personality, Essay, Appearance and Presentation of One's own self.
6. A Queen, First Runner-up and a Second Runner-up will be chosen.
7. The judges will be competent persons who are not connected with any of the above youth organizations from which the Queen is chosen. **DECISIONS OF THE JUDGES WILL BE FINAL.**
8. Once Crowned, Champaign County Fair Queen, if she is unable to complete the term of her reign, the title will pass to the next immediate runner-up in order of the contestant's rank, commencing with the first runner-up.
9. Once Crowned Champaign County Fair Queen, if she violates any of the provisions set forth in Rule number 5, she will relinquish her title as set forth in rule number 9.
10. Once Crowned Champaign County Fair Queen, if she chooses to marry or become pregnant, she will relinquish her title as set forth in rule number 9.
11. The Queen will be required to attend the 2021 Functions and Activities throughout the week and make herself available upon request of the Champaign County Fair Board. If she cannot fulfill her obligation, she will relinquish her title as set forth in rule number 9.

12. The Queen will represent Champaign County at the 2022 Ohio Fair's Queen Contest. If she cannot compete, she will relinquish her title as set forth in rule number 9.
13. The Queen will be required to attend and make herself available for the various functions throughout the year; such as parades, banquets and meetings upon the request of the Champaign County Fair Board. If she cannot fulfill her obligation, she will relinquish her title as set forth in rule number 9.
14. An application must be completed.

The Champaign County Fair Queen's Committee has chosen to abide by The Ohio Fair Managers Association, rules and regulations. The Ohio Fair Managers Association is directly responsible for The Ohio Fairs' Queen Contest. In order for Champaign County Fair Queen to be eligible for The Ohio Fairs' Queen Contest she must abide by their Rules & Regulations.
