Memorial Scholarship Guidelines

Deadline April 1, 2019

In memory of Matt Calland, family and friends are offering scholarships in his name. Matt, a fun loving, outgoing person passed away in an automobile accident in December 2009. He was a 10-year 4-H member and on the Champaign County Jr. Fairboard. Matt was also a 4-year member of the A.B. Graham FFA.

Requirements:

Must be a 2019 graduating senior that has exhibited in the Champaign County Fair or will be at the 2019 Champaign County Fair.

Must have been a 4H or FFA member for three years or more.

Must be enrolled as a full-time student (or plan to attend) a post-secondary college or training program and majoring in agriculture OR a related field (e.g. truck driving, diesel mechanic, Ag. related accounting, Ag. related construction...)

Must have a minimum GPA of 2.50.

Must submit on or before April 1, 2019 to the Graham High School Guidance Department, 7800 W. U.S. Hwy 36, St. Paris, OH 43072:

- A completed Matt Calland Memorial Scholarship application form (when answering essay questions, please refrain from using your name or family's names)
- A reference letter from applicant's 4H club advisor or FFA advisor, that DOES NOT reference applicant's name
- An official high school transcript.
- A high quality wallet sized picture (winner's pictures to be displayed on a banner at the Matt Calland Memorial Truck Pull on May 18, 2019).

Winners' names will be given to the guidance counselors at their school by May 1, 2019, so that each student can be recognized for their accomplishment at their school's honors night.

Winners' will be guests at the Matt Calland Memorial Truck Pull, which will take place on May 18, at the Champaign County Fairgrounds.

Applications for scholarships can be obtained from Champaign County Guidance Departments, FFA Instructors, and at the Champaign County OSU Extension office.
