GUIDELINES FOR CHAMPAIGN CO. 4-H FAMILY & CONSUMER SCIENCES COMMITTEE SCHOLARSHIP

- 1. Scholarship is available to high school senior 4-Hers planning to attend a two or four year accredited college in the fall, or to any 4-Her currently attending a two or four year accredited college.
- 2. Scholarship applicants must have completed at least one non-livestock project (nutrition, clothing, woodworking, bicycles, photography, creative arts, etc.) in each of the last two years in 4-H. Must be currently taking a non-livestock project.
- 3. Scholarship applications will be judged by a panel of current members of the Champaign County 4-H Family & Consumer Sciences Committee. The decision by the judges will be final. The number and amount of scholarships to be given each year will be determined by the Committee.
- 4. Scholarship applicants will be judged on the basis of 4-H work, answers to written questions on application, the Ohio 4-H Achievement Record, and recommendation sheet to be completed by the applicant's advisor or other 4-H Leader. A score sheet will be used by judges to determine winner(s). *The Ohio 4-H Achievement Record needs to be obtained on-line at champaign.osu.edu/4h and completed.* If one was completed earlier this year for other scholarships and awards, another one does not need to be done. The advisor recommendation sheet is enclosed; please give it to your 4-H advisor or other 4-H leader if your advisor is a parent.
- 5. A check that is payable to the applicant and their college choice will be presented at the 4-H Modeling event at the Champaign Co. Fair. Failure to notify the Committee of their college choice within one year of the scholarship announcement will nullify that particular applicant as a recipient. The scholarship will then be awarded to an alternate who was chosen but not announced at the time of the original judging.
- 6. Scholarship forms are available at the 4-H Extension Office and in the guidance office of each of the five high schools in Champaign County. Deadline for return of completed application is **April 5, 2024.** The scholarship winner will be announced by the end of April.
- 7. Past scholarship recipients are **not** eligible to apply again.
