# Ohio 4-H Achievement Record



## The gateway to state and national 4-H opportunities, trips, and experiences!

The Ohio 4-H Achievement Record is a comprehensive record of a 4-H member's career, accomplishments, and achievements. It is a great way to capture all the experiences they have had in 4-H, practice for filling out future job or college applications, and get a head start on applying for scholarships.

There are 27 project area categories in which to apply, such as individual animal projects, citizenship, community service, clothing, creative arts, woodworking, shooting sports, leadership, and more! 4-H members can submit multiple achievement records in different categories based on their 4-H involvement. State winners in each category win a trip to events such as National 4-H Congress, National Dairy Conference and the Shooting Sports Teen Leadership Institute. These events encourage members to expand their skills, engage with other 4-H members, and inspire them to make an impact in their communities!

## How do I get started?

Start by filling out the Achievement Record. The Ohio 4-H Achievement record can be found at [ohio4h.org/awardsandscholarships](https://ohio4h.org/awardsandscholarships). Sections include 4-H project work, 4-H participation, major 4-H honors, 4-H community service and citizenship activities, 4-H educational leadership, office and committee leadership, and non-4-H experiences, in addition to a written 4-H story and photo page reflecting on the member's 4-H experiences and impact.



### 1. Contact your county office

Contact your county 4-H professional for information about county deadlines, review process, and what local opportunities may be available through completing the achievement record!



### 2. Complete the Achievement Record

Complete all sections of the achievement record form. Be sure to follow the guidelines and show a cumulative record of your 4-H career! Applications can be tailored to the project area you are applying for.



### 3. Submit to your county office

Submit to your county 4-H professional by the deadline. State selections are made in February and state winners are notified in the spring.

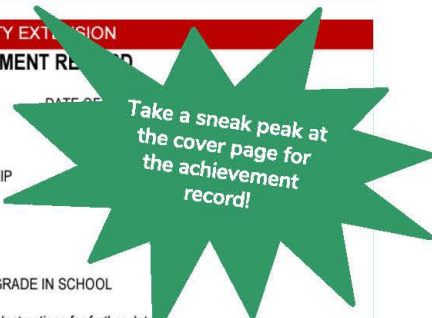

# Beef Information

## Beef State Fair and Best Show Info

NEW for 2024: Ohio State Fair will NOT be providing EID tags for market beef entries. Exhibitors must get their own 840 tags. The EID 840 tag number MUST be listed on the envelope with the DNA sample. The DNA sample kits will be available in the Extension Office in November. State Fair deadline is January 15<sup>th</sup> to submit DNA sample.

Youth showing at any of the BEST sanctioned shows must have EID tags in their calves prior to the first show in which they exhibit. BEST shows prior to January 15 deadline to submit samples to OSF include: *Mardi Gras Masquerade* (November 17-19, Circleville), *AGR Holiday Classic* (December 8-10, Columbus), *Saddle & Sirloin Spectacular* (December 29-31, Circleville), and *Scarlet & Gray Midwest Showdown* (January 5-7, Columbus).

**The 840 tags have arrived.** Anyone planning on Exhibiting at the State Fair or County Fair and the BEST Series, may pick up a tag at the Extension Office if needed.



## Market Beef and Dairy Steer Weigh-ins

If you plan to take a market beef or dairy steer project in 2024, it must be weighed in at the December weigh-in on the 16<sup>th</sup>. Weigh-ins will be 8am-10am. The member does not have to be present to weigh the animal. Cards must be filled out prior to unloading. Please don't hold up the line because cards are incomplete. Cards are available at the Extension Office prior to weigh in or they will be available that day.

Animals being weighed and tagged must be in the exhibitor's name. Following weigh-in date, entries will be posted for any corrections to be made by January 1. Additional details will be posted as we get closer to the date.

## Ohio 4-H Pathways to the Future announces youth engagement app

Published on October 18, 2023

Beginning in October, Ohio middle- and high school-aged youth will have the opportunity to track their Ohio 4-H youth development participation and earn digital badges in the skills needed to be successful in the future.

The Ohio 4-H Pathways to the Future initiative partnered with Sutable to design BuckeyeNext, an app in which young people earn points for activities, event attendance, and accomplishments during their 4-H career. Built like a game, youth can easily identify the opportunities available through Ohio 4-H, organize their categories of participation, and track their cumulative progress in real time.

“BuckeyeNext lets youth keep track of their accomplishments in real time,” said Margo Overholt-Seckel, program manager for Ohio 4-H Workforce Development and Pathways. “It provides insight about how 4-H experiences align with various skills that employers are seeking in their future workforce.”

Youth who participate will create a digital portfolio and transcript that demonstrate how their abilities align with the eight career readiness competencies identified by the National Association of Colleges and Employers.

“BuckeyeNext is the result of hard work and hours of thinking outside the box to make recordkeeping easier and provide certifications for our members,” said Jessica Adams, 4-H educator in Miami County. “Our hard work paid off when we were announced as one of three Sutable Innovator Award recipients.”

Ohio 4-H youth from 20 counties piloted the platform during the summer at the Ohio 4-H Spark EXPO to track their learning experiences.

“The BuckeyeNext app is very easy and simple to use. It helps with 4-H records because you can look back and remember what all you’ve done, and the competition part pushes you to do more!” said Sophia Preston, a Fairfield County 4-H member.
