Reminder Goat Born and Raised Papers can be turned in during goat weigh-ins or in the Jr. Fair Office prior to day of weigh-in.

Sheep Born and Raised Papers can be turned in during sheep weigh-in or in the Jr. Fair Office prior to day of weigh-in.

Reminders to pay stall/pen fees at secretary's office.

Some clubs still need to pay their club dues. You should know who you are and you will also be receiving an individual call.

DUNF Forms will be available for pick-up in Jr. Fair Office. Please make sure that you complete them before coming to scales.

When weighing animals, social distancing and mask wearing is in effect. Barns are considered indoor even if they have open sides.

Individual weigh cards will not be used this year. We will be recording information on one spreadsheet to help eliminate touch points. The only papers that will come to the scale is DUNF form.

All Directors' Order from the Ohio Department of Health that will be followed. Details can be found on Ohio.Gov Website. Some items to point out.

-Curfew 10pm daily. Everyone will need to leave the fairgrounds or go to their campers.

-If an event goes past 10pm, everyone will be expected to leave within 30 minutes of the conclusion of the event.

Facial coverings:

All individuals in attendance at and participating in 4-H and FFA Junior Fair activities shall wear a facial covering at all times when:

- a. In any indoor location (this includes all barns with a roof) which is not a residence (camper) or
- b. Outdoors and unable to consistently maintain a distance of six feet or more from individuals who are not members of their family/household.

Facial coverings do not apply when:

- a. Under age of 10
- b. Medical conditions including those with respiratory conditions that restrict breathing, mental health conditions, or disability, where the ability to see the mouth is essential for communication;
- d. The individual is seated and actively engaged in consuming food or beverage.

Junior Fair Animal Exhibitions and Shows

- a. Each participant must perform a daily symptom assessment that should include taking temperature with a thermometer, monitoring for fever and watching for coughing or trouble breathing. Anyone experiencing symptoms must stay home.
- b. Only 10 exhibitors will be in the ring at one time.
- c. Spectators and others in the exhibition area must follow current orders regarding mass gatherings and social distancing. (A show may be stopped if this is not being followed. We ask that if your child is not showing, please allow room for others to watch their kids.
- d. Shows will be live on Facebook. Swine will be on Champaign Co Fair facebook page. All shows will be in Woodruff Show arena will be live on champaigncountyohio4-H facebook page.

What to expect during a show:

- 1. Shows may move a little slower than normal.
- 2. Exhibitors can only bring their animals to the make-up area when called up. When a class enters the ring, the next class will be called up.
- 3. It is recommended and preferred to have no one except the exhibitor in make-up area with their animal. As of now, Cattle exhibitors may have one helper if needed for controlling animal. (This may vary per specie show- details to come) The helper must follow all mask orders and move completely out of make-up area so the next class can come in and may not gather around doorways.
- 4. There will be a table with awards at the exit of the ring where members can pick up their awards when exiting.
- 5. There will be several announcements throughout the show reminding the audience of rules and guidelines. If spectators are not compliant, the show may be stopped or may continue with no spectators.
- 6. Exhibitors do not have to wear mask in the show ring. All other times, they should abide by all the state orders.

Let's all work together to give our youth a positive experience to end the summer safe and healthy.
