Poultry Poster Requirements

All entries must be submitted at the 2021 Skill-a-thon. No expectations!

- Entry in the poster contest is optional for any poultry exhibitor.
- Posters must be a 36" x 48" open tri-fold (36" x 24" closed). Other sizes will be disqualified.
- The Name, Club Name, Age, and Level must be written on the back of the poster ONLY. If the information is somewhere other than the back, the entry will be disqualified.
- The participants picture can not be on the poster anywhere or will be disqualified.
- All parts and pieces of poster must be securely attached.
- Awards will be announced on Sunday during the Poultry Breeding Show at the Fair.
- Rosettes will be awarded to 1st -5th place.
- 1st -5th place poster will be displayed in the Activities Building and must be picked up on Friday at 3pm.
- All other posters must be claimed on Sunday. Posters will be disposed if they are not claimed following the breeding show.

Junior: Ages 9-11

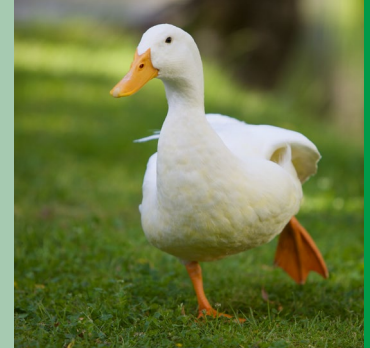
Topic: Parts of male bird (Related to this year's project)
