

## 2021 RABBIT PROJECT and BOOK GUIDELINES

### BREEDING RABBIT PROJECT

---

#### PROJECT GUIDELINES:

##### Breeding Rabbit Project:

**1<sup>st</sup> year** – 2 rabbits – preferably juniors

**2<sup>nd</sup> year** – 4 rabbits – 2 juniors and 2 6-8's or seniors

**3<sup>rd</sup> year** – 4 rabbits – 2 juniors and 2 6-8's or seniors plus one unit from the optional group.

**4<sup>th</sup> year** – 4 rabbits – 2 juniors and 2 6-8's or seniors plus up to two **different** units from the optional group.

**5<sup>th</sup> year and up** – 2 juniors and 2 6-8's or seniors plus up to four **different** units from the optional group.

Optional Group is:   1 Single Fryer  
                               1 Meat Pen  
                               1 Brood Pair  
                               1 Bred & Raised

#### RESOURCE and PROJECT BOOKS, FEED RECORDS:

##### Feed Record:

The Breeding Rabbit Project will use the feed record available on the website or from your advisor rather than the feed records in the project books. Feed records must be completed and turned in at Skill-a-thon.

##### Project Book:

Champaign County will use the Rabbit Resource Handbook and the Breeding Rabbit Project and Record Book for the Breeding Rabbit Project. Note that the Breeding Rabbit Project and Record Book is divided into three sections- Beginner, Intermediate and Advanced. The book calls for members to use each section of the book multiple years. For example, the beginning level is indicated to be the first three years of the project. We will NOT follow that recommendation. Please apply the beginning section to first year members, the intermediate section to second- and third-year members, and the advanced section to fourth year and up. Project books for the Breeding Rabbit Project will not be turned in. We will not be using the Market Rabbit Project and Record Book.
