

**Rabbit Show Remark Card**

1. Fill in the rabbit's ear number.
2. Fill in your name and address.
3. Fill in the name of the show that you are showing at.
4. Fill in the date of the show.
5. Fill in your rabbit's breed.
6. Fill in the variety of your rabbit's breed. Variety generally refers to color but some breeds show only in limited varieties. Example: Mini-Lops show only in broken or solid varieties. Consult the ARBA standards for more info on how your breed shows.
7. Circle Buck(male) or Doe(female).
8. Circle the class you are entering.
 

Sr. - A 4 class rabbit that is over 6 months and within the weight limits for your breed, or a 6 class rabbit that is 8 months of age or over and within the weight limits for your breed.

6/8 - A 6 class rabbit that is 6 to 8 months of age and not over the weight limit of the breed for this class. Note that some breeds do not have 6/8 classes. Consult the ARBA standards for more info on how your breed shows.

Jr. - A rabbit under 6 months of age and is within the weight limits of this class for the breed.

Pre Jr. - A rabbit that is under 3 months of age. Not showable unless specifically allowed.

Fryer - a single rabbit shown for meat qualities, not over 10 weeks old, weight of 3-5 pounds.

Meat Pen – consists of 3 rabbits, all of same breed and variety, age limit of 10 weeks, weight of 3-5 pounds. Put all three ear numbers on one entry card.

Fur – a class to judge the fur of the rabbit.
9. Turn in the card at the registration table and pay any entry fees required.



You are ready to show and just need to wait for your class to be called. Writers for the judge will fill in the remarks on your entry form and once you've shown you can pick up the duplicate copy from the writer's table. Return to the registration table to collect any ribbons or payback, if it is applicable. If you have won Best of Breed you will need to stay for the Best of Show class at the end of the show.

Understanding your remark card after you've shown:

No. in class- the number of rabbits entered

Award- the placing your rabbit received in the class

No. Exhibitors- the number of people who entered rabbits in the class

B.O.B.- Best of Breed, best of all the classes and varieties of the breed

B.O.S.- Best of Breed Opposite Sex, best of all the classes and varieties of the breed, and the opposite sex of the best of breed rabbit

B.O.G. and B.O.S.G.- Best of Group, Best Opposite Sex of Group, these are for those breeds that are shown by groups after they are shown by variety, as are the Netherland Dwarf breed. These winners move on to go for B.O.B. and B.O.S.

B.O.V. and B.O.S.V.- Best of Variety, Best Opposite Sex of Variety, these are the winners of each variety of a breed, these winners move on to compete for the above awards.

Best Sr./Best 6/8/Best Jr./Best Pre-Jr.- These are the best of each class as entered.

All other information marked on the card is the judge's comments for your animal. Here you will learn what is good or bad about your animal, and these comments will help you to make improvements for future shows.
