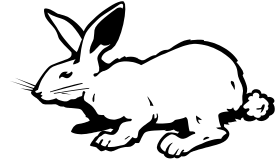




## 2024 Cavy & Rabbit Poster Contest



### Guidelines & Rules of Contest:

- Participant must be a member of a Champaign County 4-H or FFA club and carrying a rabbit or cavy project. Pet rabbit projects may also enter this contest.
- Participant may enter only one poster per project per year.
- Cavy & Rabbit posters will be judged separately by project level as follows:
  - Level I: Ages 8 - 10
  - Level II: Ages 11 - 13
  - Level III: Ages 14 & Up
  - All ages are as of January 1<sup>st</sup> of the current year
- Posters are to be turned in on Sunday, July 14<sup>th</sup> at the 4-H Activities Building at the Fair grounds starting at 5:00 pm. Clubs may collect all 4-H members posters and turn them in as a club. Please be sure to put a post it note with kids name, club name and age as of January 1<sup>st</sup>. **Do Not put their names on posters. No Late Entries Accepted.**
- Awards will be announced at the Fair on Sunday, 2PM at the Rabbit/Cavy Barn.
- Ribbons will be given to 1 - 10 Place
- Cash prizes will be awarded 1 - 3 Place
- A plaque will be awarded for the "Best Overall Poster" for both rabbit & cavy
- 1 - 5 Place Posters will be displayed in the barn and may be removed at 3PM on Friday. All other posters may be claimed on Sunday at the Rabbit Barn. Any unclaimed posters will be disposed of on Saturday.

### Poster Guidelines

- Poster board/Foam Board to be used
- Educational poster on any rabbit or cavy topic
- Maximum size of poster is to be 28" X 22"
- Will be judged on creativity, Neatness, participant's knowledge of subject matter
- Poster must not have participant's name, picture, age, or club name on front or back. Posters that contain any personal identification will be disqualified.
- All parts/pieces of poster must be securely attached.

**Clover Buds** may participate in the poster contest. These posters will not be judged; however, the same rules and guidelines must be followed. Participants will receive a participation ribbon and special recognition on Sunday of the fair.
