- 3. First Year Project members are <u>not</u> eligible to compete.
- 4. Titles: Rabbit King or Queen Ages 13-18

Cavy King or Queen – Ages 13-18

Rabbit Prince or Princess – Ages 9-12

Cavy Prince or Princess – Ages 9-12

NOTE: Ages are as of January 1st of the current Fair year.

- 6. Applicant is required to participate in a personal interview that will take place on **Sunday**, **July 14**, **2024** at the 4H Activities Building at the Fairgrounds. Each applicant will be given an approximate interview time. No alternate times or dates will be available.
- 7. Royalty Contest Scoring:
