Dear Dairy Feeder Exhibitors and Advisors:

Congratulations on selecting a dairy feeder project this year. For your project to be complete and eligible to come to the Champaign County Fair, you must complete the following:

- All 4-H/FFA members must tag and weigh their animal in on Saturday, May 8 between 8am-10am at the fairgrounds beef barn. (see details under weigh-in) Dairy Feeders do not require ID forms or pictures May 15 because they are being tagged in for ID.
- 4-H members must attend a minimum of 5 club meetings or more as required by your specific club and bring your completed packet to skill-a-thon.
- FFA members must complete requirements of your chapter.
- 4-H/FFA members must complete skill-a-thon July 14-20.
- Attend Quality Assurance Program prior to June 1, 2021

Required Vaccinations:

As soon as you have your calf (anytime from 1 day of age up until April 15)

Inforce 3[®] - 1cc in each nostril -

*Inforce 3[®] is highly preferred, but Nasalgen[®] or TSV-2 could be substituted

The vaccines are available at the Extension Office for \$3 each.

THE FOLLOWING VACCINES ARE REQUIRED FOR ALL CALVES

At Weigh-in (if given prior to weigh-in should be no more than 3 weeks before)

- 1.) 5-way viral respiratory - BVD, IBR, PI-3, BRSV
- 2.) 7-way Clostridial
- 3.) Mannheimia haemolytica (+/- Pasteurella multocida) - One-Shot[®] or Once PMH[®]

One to two weeks prior to the fair

Inforce 3[®] - 1cc in each nostril (This vaccine will be distributed and included in price of vaccines at Weigh-in on May 8th)

TAG-IN – May 8, 2021 8am-10am

Exhibitors may tag in four calves. Two of those calves may go to fair.

When arriving on tag-in day, have your weigh cards completed before unloading. (Cards are available at the Extension Office and at weigh-in. Livestock trailers will enter the Powell Avenue Main entrance and cross the ditch toward the North side of the beef barn. There will be

a table set up outside at the edge of the barn where you will have your cards checked and pay for vaccinations, implants, or wormer prior to unloading calves. Once paid, you will receive a color coded slip that will need to go with each calf and card as you go through the line so those giving shots will know what each calf will receive.

All calves must be dehorned at some point and healed over before the fair.

All calves must be castrated or banded prior to weigh-in.

All calves must be **purebred Dairy Breeds** only and identifying marks must meet breed standards. If you are not sure, contact your advisor, a member of the Dairy Council or the Extension Office.

If your calf is vaccinated prior to weigh-in, you must bring the Vaccine Document form (attached with this letter) or the calf will receive vaccinations at the weigh in. The cost of vaccinations are \$19. This includes the pre-fair nasal spray that should be administered two weeks prior to fair.

If an animal is disqualified at weigh-in for any reason (not a purebred, hernia, etc.) member will have 2 weeks to replace the calf if they choose. Member must contact Max Perry, Fair Board Dairy Committee Chairman or Melinda Ryan, 4-H Educator to make arrangements for tagging of replacement calf.

FAIR

There will be a stall fee again this year of \$10 per animal with a \$100/family maximum. The fees should be paid at the Fair Secretary's Office after it opens in July.
