OSU Extension Successful Co-Parenting

What is Successful Co-Parenting? Successful Co-Parenting is an educational program that helps parents minimize the negative effects of separation and divorce on children as they adjust to the process of parenting together while living apart. It is offered in cooperation with the Champaign County Common Pleas Courts and conducted by a qualified professional from the Ohio State University Extension, Champaign County Office.

How Do I Register? Pre-registration is required one week prior to the program. To register or for more information, contact OSU Extension, Champaign County. Child care is not provided. Failure to pre-register may result in class cancellation or not having a prepared certificate of participation. If participants arrive more than 15 minutes late, they must attend the next month's session.

What is the Fee? Registration fees are \$25.00 per person and are due one week before the session. Cash is accepted and credit card pre-payment at the OSU Extension office.

Certificates Certificates will be given at the end of the session to those attending who have paid the fee. Copies of the certificates will be sent to the Common Pleas Courts and filed.
